Drop Off Routine



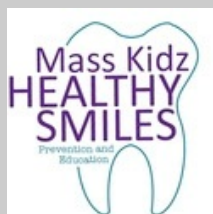
With colder temperatures here, I would like to take this time to remind parents/guardians of JFK's morning drop off routine to help make the morning and afternoon drop off procedures run smoothly and safely.

- At no time should cars be left unattended in the drop off lane. This is a fire lane and per MGL, parking here is against the law. If you would like to walk your child to the main doors, please park in a space in the parking lot.
- When dropping your child off in the morning, please pull as far up as possible (past the cross walk). This will allow more cars to pull up and unload.
- There are two lanes for school traffic.
 - The right lane is for **drop off**. **EVERY** parent wishing to drop students off must wait their turn in the drop off lane.
 - The left lane is for traffic continuing past the drop off lane. Cars in this lane should **NOT** attempt to drive past the line of cars, then cut back into the drop off lane. This is dangerous and puts children, drivers and staff at risk for an accident.
- The parking lot is for parking only. Parents should not use this as a cut through. We encourage anyone to park in a designated parking spot and walk their child to the door. Blocking cars or dropping kids off is a safety concern.
